

PE-Backed Software Company Conducts Nationwide CEO Search



Objective: Find the Best Fit for New Leadership

Private equity firm KT Capital Partners, LP, needed a new CEO for one of its subsidiaries, The Estimating Edge, a 30-year-old tech company catering to the construction industry.
